Phase I

Biblical Studies

1072- Survey of the New TestamentDr. Lucille Greene Engage in a general overview of the divisions, time periods, places, events, people, and archaeology of the New Testament sections of the Bible.

Phase II

Church Growth and Discipleship

7024- Discovering Your Spiritual Gift.....Sis. Lucille Calvin Help students to understand who God has uniquely made them to be. Work through a spiritual gift assessment that will help them to discover their spiritual gift(s). Their discovering their spiritual gift(s) will prepare them to move into a meaningful area of service where they best fit into the body of Christ.

Phase III

Biblical Studies

1079 - Survey of JohnDr. Donald Washington Focus on the fourth gospel and its uniqueness. Identify the specific features that characterize John's gospel and distinguish it from the Synoptic Gospels, with emphasis on John's writing and the ministry of Jesus Christ.

Biblical Studies

1089 - Survey of Romans Rev. Clifton King, Jr. Engage in an overview of major issues presented in Paul's doctrinal letter to the Roman Christians. Students will come to recognize each doctrinal truth presented in the book.

Fine Arts and Literacy

9005 - Writing Techniques II Sis. Vera Watson Focus on the Certificate of Progress Program writing requirements for Phase 3. Emphasis will be placed on the writing of documented research and the development of other skills necessary to complete the writing assignment in this phase. Help introduce the students to the library and the use of reference materials.

Phase IV

Biblical Studies

1112 - Survey of Revelation Dr. Cecil Ashford Explore the book of Revelation, with emphases on authorship, date, theme, and recipients. Discuss the prophetic themes, symbols, and interpretations of various revelations.

Church Administration

6013- Organizing the church for Christian Education.....Sis. Lourine Robinson Focus on the various administrative and organizational skills needed to organize the Christian education department. Emphasis placed on structure , leadership, and staffing needs for Christian education.

Fine Arts and Literacy

9024- The Computer in the Life of the Church..... Sis. Yolanda Johnson Train pastors, office workers, Christian educators, and others who want to utilize computer technology in the church. Issues in administration, setting up computer labs, tutorials on Bible study, as well as membership record keeping and nurture will be covered in this course.
